

The Churches in Canada Prayer

Sep. 19th to Oct. 3rd, 2022

Burden

Our burden of prayer is not for any prayer movement, outward activity, or religious obligation, but a call to join all the saints in the Lord's recovery to cooperate with Christ's heavenly ministry in the prayer ministry of the church. May this period of time usher us into the life of prayer of the Lord Jesus and cause us to be persons of prayer as the corporate God-man to consummate this age with our kingdom prayers. May we establish a personal habit and culture of prayer in the church life so that "His kingdom come; His will be done, as in heaven, so also on earth" (Matt. 6:10)

Attitude and Prayer

- May the Spirit of grace and supplication be poured out upon us (Zech. 12:10)
- May the Lord fill us with an unquenchable burden for prayer (Eph. 6:18)
- May we linger at the incense altar to minister to Him (Acts 13:1-2a)
- May His victorious blood protect us, and His cross operate to subdue our flesh
- May the prevailing prayers of the saints ascend to the heavens with the resurrected and ascended Christ as incense (Rev. 8:3)

Practical Fellowship

- Personal Consecration: before we try to persevere in prayer, we should first make a vow to the Lord concerning our prayer life:
 1. Pray to Him in a definite way and say, "Lord, I mean business with You about this matter of prayer. I call heaven and earth to witness that from this time forth I will have a life of prayer. I will not be a prayerless person. Rather, I will be a praying person."
 2. If you do not have such a prayer to the Lord, you will not be able to persevere in prayer; we need to say to Him, "Lord, I am desperate about this. I offer myself to You so that I may have a prayer life. Lord, keep me in the spirit of prayer. If I forget this or neglect this, I know that You will not forget it. Remind me again and again about prayer."
 3. This kind of prayer may be regarded as a vow made to the Lord; we all need to make a vow to Him concerning our prayer life; we should tell the Lord, "Lord, I know that if I forget this vow, You will not forget it. From the very beginning, Lord, I want to clearly hand the responsibility over to You. Lord, don't let me go. Remind me to pray." (2012 Thanksgiving conference, Msg. 4, outline D)
- Definite Daily Prayer Time: 10-15 minutes each session
- Companion Prayer: twos and threes, husband and wife, family
- Church's Prayer Meeting: attend and pray at the prayer meeting
- Corporate Prayer: add 10-15 minutes of prayer for the group meetings: sisters' meeting, brother's meeting, campus meeting...

Suggested Daily Category of Prayer

Monday (9/19, 9/26, 10/3) Churches in Canada

- Eating the tree of life, that is enjoying Christ as our life supply, should be the primary matter in the church life
- the producing of overcomers through the practice of the vital groups to "...conquer the deadness of Sardis, the lukewarmness of Laodicea, and the barrenness dealt with by the Lord in John 15." (The Training and the Practice of the Vital Groups p. 35)
- The perfecting of the saints in function, coordination, and service (Eph. 4:11-16)
- The shepherding of the saints of all ages (John 21:15-17)
- The practice of the God-ordained way church life in the homes (Acts 2:42, 46-47)
- All the saints to be renewed in their heart toward mankind, to be laboring priests of the gospel (Matt. 24:14; Rom.15:16; Rom. 12:1; Col. 1:28, 1 Peter 2:5), to personally, directly, regularly, and faithfully visit and contact people for their spiritual welfare, to bear remaining fruit, and to shepherd the Lord's sheep for the increase of the recovery and the building up of the Body

Tuesday (9/20, 9/27) Lord's Move in Canada

- Raising up and forming of the full-time team in Calgary and the Lord's strengthening of the teams in Montreal, Toronto (southern Ontario), and Vancouver
- **GTCC/BfC**: regular distribution of the English, French, and Spanish bibles and follow up of Bible recipients including the 2022 BfC summer distributions in Canada
- Migration and strengthening of cities: Ottawa, Kingston, Hamilton, Guelph, Charlottetown, PEI, Halifax, Red Deer, Regina, Lethbridge, Quebec City
- Raising up of new local churches: Airdrie, Chatham/Kent, Oakville, St. John, Langley
- The people of this land: (1) sinners to be saved and seeking believers to come to the full knowledge of the truth, (2) proper and useful ones to be gained for the recovery, and (3) a demographically proportionate number of local people to be added to the recovery
- **Gospel to the nations**: the French-speaking, Spanish-speaking, Low German-speaking, Asian languages (Chinese, Indian, Korean...), African-Canadian, Russian/Ukrainian, Middle eastern, and indigenous peoples.

Wednesday (9/21, 9/28) **Lord's Move in Other Continents**

- Lord's Move in Europe (<https://www.lordsmove.org/>)
 - The University campuses in Europe including the gospel trips to Germany and Switzerland Oct 10th to 23rd, that the Lord would gain many young Germans and Swiss as remaining fruit, and for the spread of the Lord's testimony in all the cities through the gospel trips.
 - The local saints and serving ones in Europe would be blended with the Ukrainian refugees for the strengthening and building up of the Lord's testimony in key European cities; that the saints in Russia and Ukraine would be kept in the oneness of the Body and the reality of the new man; that the tripartite being of the saints in the besieged cities would be protected and preserved for the Lord's interests. Pray according to the footnote in 1 Kings 8:48 "...no matter for whom we are praying, our prayers should be aimed at the interests of God, i.e., at Christ and the church as God's interests on earth, for the fulfilling of God's economy."

- the migration of burdened saints to six designated European cities - Barcelona, Brussels, Dublin, Lisbon, Rome, and Zurich

Thursday (9/22, 9/29) The Kingdom Prayer to Bind and Loose

- The oneness and one accord in the Body and among the churches to carry out the Lord's present move
- The binding of the power of darkness that is behind all kinds of opposition from all religions, all human organizations, and all worldly powers for the casting down of Satan and the ushering in of the kingdom of God (binding the power of darkness)
- The loosing of the leading in the Lord's recovery and cooperation of the saints and churches with the Lord's move in the current world situation and crisis
- The preservation of society from moral degradation and corruption that the hand of God to be upon the leaders in the highest levels of government to guide the North American nations in the fear of God, in reverence for God's Word, and in respect for His principles, so that the church life can go on in peace to cooperate with God's desire (1 Tim. 2:1-4)

Friday (9/23, 9/30) The Ministry of the Word

- The blending coworkers: their health, service, and traveling
- The release of the Spirit's speaking to the churches in the 7 feasts and the blending among the saints and churches (Eph. 6:19-20)
- All the saints in the Lord's recovery entering in and to be constituted with the truth (HWMR, the life studies, and high peak truths)
- Propagation of the ministry of brother Watchman Nee and Witness Lee through various mediums to gain the seekers and to perfect the believers for their growth in life unto maturity thus to produce the one new man and to produce the bride of Christ
- The services and the serving saints at Living Stream Ministry, Defense and Confirmation Project, Bibles for America, Bibles for Canada, and Rhema Literature Distributors (Phil. 2:25, 28-30)

Saturday (9/24, 10/1) The Raising Up of the Next Generation

- Gaining proper and useful vessels in the college campuses
- All ages of saints in the churches function according to their capacity, especially in the raising up of the next generation—the children, young people, and college-age saints—for the Lord's testimony according to His economy
- The growing ranks of young working saints (ages 20-40) in the churches, both the job-dropping and the job-keeping saints, including the graduates of the full-time training, to be strong in the spirit to overcome in order to live Christ for the church and to be normal functioning members in the service of the Body to bear the primary burden in the practical church life
- The full-time training ([FTTA](#), [FTTA-XB](#), [FTTA-MA](#), FTTAMx, [FTTL](#), ...), including the trainees, the trainers, and the serving ones (2 Thess. 3:9; Heb. 13:7; 1 Tim. 4:6; 2 Tim. 4:6, 3:10)

- The establishing and preservation of strong and spiritual marriages and healthy and sanctified families as solid foundational units for the building up of the local churches
- The raising up of the next generation of saints to overcome sin, the world, the flesh, and the self and to be constituted with the divine life and the divine truth, so that the move of God may continue on the earth for the accomplishment of His divine economy (1 John 2:13-14, 4:4)

Lord's Day (9/25, 10/2) The New Revival

- The aspiration, realization and continuation of the new revival among all the saints in His recovery through the pursuit of the high peak truths, the practice of the God-man living and the universal shepherding of all the believers (the bringing in of the new revival)
- The vitalization of all the churches in the Lord's recovery through the exercise and practice of all aspects of the God-ordained way to become a living testimony of Jesus in all the localities for an anti-testimony to the degradation around us (praying for all the churches that all the churches would be vitalized)
